

- Organized all programming for the Center (e.g., intramural sports and student activities)


ASSOCIATE HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH | JUNE 2014 - JUNE 2016

- Executed the daily operations of the women's basketball program which included recruiting, coordinating logistics for travel, budgeting, strength and conditioning, scouting, player development, and academic supervision
- Recorded an overall record of 47 – 11 (2014 – 2016) and back-to-back Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) West Division Championships
- Guided the program to become only one of three teams in school history to advance to the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Tournament
- Won 15 straight games ranking top 20 in the NCAA
- First team in school history to be ranked in the NCAA USA Today Coaches Poll Top 2 ranked 25th ranked 25th (2015 – 2016)
- Best record since 1971-1972 season
- Most wins since 1996-1997 season
- Signed four Junior College All-Americans (2015)
- Produced four All-Conference and two All-Tournament selections
- Former player invited to the Women's National Basketball Association Combine

WHEREAS, Coach Slater was asked to serve the University in a temporary role as Interim Athletic Director, during which time he worked diligently to improve all University athletic programs; and


WHEREAS, the Kentucky State University Board of Regents acknowledges that Coach Slater distinguished himself by serving honorably in all his roles during his tenure at the University.


